Johnie went to Roanoke. received from P. Cote on acct of a hundred now sold to him at 30.¢ 1,000.¢ and received from Hallemstein from William 2,000.¢ sent a gift to Alfred for 500.¢ and paid 500.¢ to Robt. Bank Via. Gustaf hauled from the station 3 loads of wood with 4 horse.

4 SATURDAY [277-88]

Brought up some manure from the pens and made the mud for brick makers.

Johnie came back by the evening train.

Gustaf hauled over 3 loads of wood.

5 SUNDAY—18 aft Trin [278-87]

Dividends due at Bank. (8^h 23^m P.M.

Warm day, north east wind, cloudy in the south, hope it rains. Played polo at Las Lunas.
