Bullock's carts brought a load of posts & a load of barrilas only one peon & the capatazy at the fencing. Mrs + Mr O. Benity went to the town & on to the Lomas Mr Burke returned from the Germania the oraca killed by dogs in 70 Mr Park came did not see him but he left word that he wanted his cattle changed into another pasture, Horse Rings not here. Remunio 1/2 a day.

4 Easter TUESDAY [94-271]

Holiday at Law Offices

A very windy day, cloudy at times, Juan Coosa came about six horses he had bought but would not let them go as I did not know anything about them, another Chestnut mare slipped a foal, received two telegrams one from W. Coay & one from Cecilio Barrios, saying that they could not go on with the horses to the Chacho, it was sent from Pilar, I depatched the same one to O. Benity Chalchague also sent one to Cecilio to tell him to stay where he was for orders changed the mares (Chestnut) back into 70 Pasture. Bullock's carts brought horse two loads of posts. A Novillo died in Pilar's Pasture

5 WEDNESDAY [95-270]

Oxford Easter Term begins. Dividends due at Bank

A beautiful day. Marked the line for the pig Pasture. changed Mr. Nathan's cattle into 70 & put the novillos from there into that vacated by Mr. Nathan's cattle. also parted 2 Barrios from 70 + 5 from 70 & put them into 70 two oracas died in 70. Brought two loads of posts home from Station there are no more. Mr Burke left today for Buenos Ayres. Mrs + Mr O. Benity went for a drive in the afternoon the Phanchico took a large balancine for harrows which he said belonged to him, engaged an old man 1/2 a day to help with the cattle. but he had 1 animal at Tujan.

A beautiful day. The bullocks carts brought 50 rolls of wire & 10 bundles of Tomiquatas & box of nuts & some men also 6 bags of coal from the Station. The mares shipped their foals. The ground is very hard for ploughing. I hear that the Somas have the peste among their cattle & that they are losing sheep by dogs. Ivan Koro came again today about horses but would not let them go. Jants Williams off 2 1/2 days 1-50. The well men had a wife to make a bucket for getting out the mud.
1 moultrie & dead 10 1 Tiger.

7 FRIDAY [97-268]

A fine day but cloudy at times. Hosi, Henge brought one word that two dogs were killing sheep in the Patrus. I sent Saulso outside our camp to follow the dogs to their home which he did. They had killed six & bitten three others also several lambs. I went to the Comisario in the town to come, which he did after breakfast. The colonist had killed one dog & we killed the other. He is to go to the Policia & pay for damage done on Sunday. Sacre was ill so did not work. Paula commenced work bearing vanillas. Borrowed four plough shares from the Somas sent for a bag of biscuits from the town. Received 200 cartridges from Mr. Manty, killed a duck 88 yards. We want rain very badly. Another mare shipped a foal. I don't know what to do with them, suppose cannot alter it.

8 SATURDAY [98-267]

Fire Insurance Days of Grace expire

A beautiful day. Ivan Koro came again about horses, but told him I still knew nothing about them. Mr. + Mrs. Bcutty went for a drive. We want rain very badly just getting very short. Sacre did not work today.

9 Low SUNDAY [99-266]

C 11° 35' A.M.

A beautiful day. Two lambs died from the bite of the dog we killed on Friday. Mr. Nash telegraphed to know if we could take in a manada till the 16 I answered yes! Bought a gun 1500

A fine day. Saw caranchos kill a lamb which I poisoned & had the satisfaction of killing 4 birds whilst I looked on. San Buella on his way to Tiejeras. Ramon & Saac did not work were ill. Remigio, Panta & Hosi Berto 1/2 day. Too hard for the horse ploughs, so set the two men to fill up the holes round the rebeldes sent to the Lomas for ~~four~~ plough shares for the bullock ploughs. Hosi Gordonio ill so let the old man work all day. Sent to the Tiejeras for a machine for pulling water it is broken.

11 TUESDAY [101-264]

Easter Law ^{begin}

Very hot day. north wind, getting very dry. potatoes looking poor. Johnnie came sick from the Chaco. Mr. Bell here to daylight.

12 WEDNESDAY [102-263]

Hot clear sultry day. glass falling. Looks like rain.

Counted all the rebeldes potatoes and things to the 300 & potato.

Received 3,000 \$ from Santos Capitan to take care of for him.

Sold 200 muellos of the barman of the finca and 1/2 muellos to Vista Moran @ 32¢ he takes away in small lots as he needs them.

He took ten away today.

Bought a cow at the Tepes.

Cloudy weather in the morning, drizzled a little.
In the afternoon began to set up troughs in 300 or 400 feet.
Butchered one animal.
A leopard cub died in chicken.
Went sent from with a maroda to stay here a few days,
patrons looking very dry.

14 FRIDAY [104-261]

Cloudy all day, very foggy all morning.
All hands held at work on the new well.
Finished everything ready to draw water.
Four sheep dead.
Butchered a cow.

Rained quite hard last night, cool day.
Mr Brown a gentleman from the states arrived with a letter
of introduction from Hamner Hall.
Butchered a cow.
Sent 10 rapons to the station for Mr Park, also 6 sucking pigs.

Mr Park's auction sale at the
station came off, he took all his animals from here.
