and the Holy Ghost. Amen,

I, Mary Anne Haber of the City of
Pittsburg, County of Allegheny, and
State of Pennsylvania, being in feeble
health of Body, but of sound mind
Memory, and understanding, Consider-
ing the uncertainty of Life do make
this my last Will and Testament in
manner following that is to say,

First, my Will is that the Expenses
of my last sickness and Funerall
be first paid.

Second all Just debts by me owing
at the time of my death.

Third. I give and bequeath to my three
Children Barbara Coultas, Leopold my
Son, and to my Daughter Josephine
Share and Share alike, and Mrs
Coultas got already five hundred
Dollars on her share to be considered
by the division to come in the case,

Fourth. I give and bequeath to my niece
Mally Ott all of my Furniture in
my Room everything belonging to me,

Fifth. I hereby constitute and appoint
David McDowell, to be the Executor

of this my last Will and Testament
Revolking and annulling all former
Wills by me hereto for made Rectifying
and Confirming this.
