

This Agreement made the twenty third day of July Eighteen
 Hundred and sixty three between William Fenitz and partners
 W. W. Kudepeth and partners J. M. Ward and partners
 and Moses Davis and partners Witnesses: That the Said William
 Fenitz agreed to transfer to the other parties of the first part, three
 fourth parts of his right title and interest in a certain Mineral ledge
 situated on the boundary of the Mining grant of lands belonging to
 him, said ledge running in a north-westerly and South-Easterly
 direction to the distance of two thousand feet from and within said
 boundary line reserving the exclusive right of his adjacent lands,
 roads and water, That said W. W. Kudepeth and partners
 J. M. Ward and partners and Moses Davis and partners
 transfer to William Fenitz and partners their heirs and assigns
 one fourth part of their right title and interest on aforesaid Mineral
 ledge to the distance of six thousand feet from said boundary line

Furthermore aforesaid parties have agreed to name the company
 formed in virtue of this document the Santa Ottilia Copper
 and Silver Mining Company
