The punta de lanza on the Soregos is the señal, and the muesca: (cut out with a machine) is to tell the year the lambs were señalared. changing position or number of muescas every year. during 1896. The muesca was on the back of the ear. cañon (or male) lambs only have the punta de lanza *no muesca*
